ABOUT THE KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Jerry A. Krishnan, MD, PhD

Jerry Krishnan is professor of Medicine and Public Health, associate vice chancellor for Population Health Sciences, and vice chancellor for Health Affairs, University of Illinois Chicago. He was recruited from the University of Chicago in 2011 to establish the Office of the Population Health Sciences for the Health System.

Dr. Krishnan is a highly accomplished physician, researcher and educator with expertise in population health, real-world evidence, clinical guidelines methodology and healthcare operations. He holds a medical degree with honors from Baylor College of Medicine, a PhD in Clinical Investigation from Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health and has completed the Advanced Management Program at Harvard Business School. Dr. Krishnan is a leader in developing research agendas for respiratory diseases and is actively involved in multiple national and international advisory committees. His contributions have been recognized with prestigious awards including the Parker B. Francis Award and the Forrest M. Bird Lifetime Scientific Achievement Award. He is the immediate past president of the Central Society for Clinical and Translational Research.
