WAYS TO GET HELP

- 1** Call the Helpline and talk to a trained Helpline Specialist, in your preferred language.
- 2** Answer a few questions on the Helpline website for a tailored list of treatment options specific to your needs and in your preferred area of the state.
- 3** Explore the Helpline website for information on treatment options, opioid overdose prevention, and how to help someone with substance use disorder.

- ♥ Offer other resources, such as links to housing

Callers can receive follow-up services from Helpline Clinicians to support their access to treatment services



Warm transfers

Callers can get directly transferred to a treatment program by a Helpline Specialist during intake hours

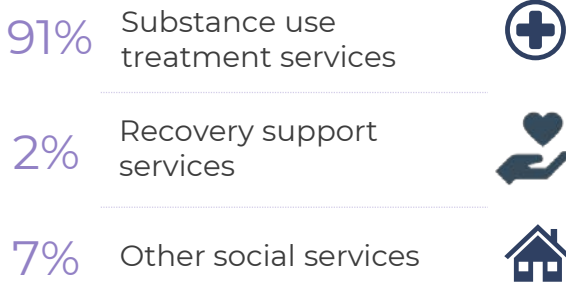

GENDER OF CALLERS



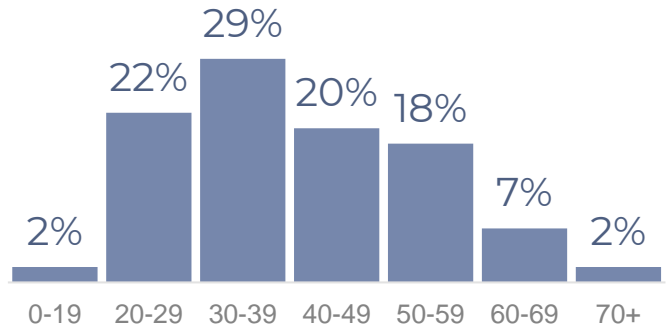

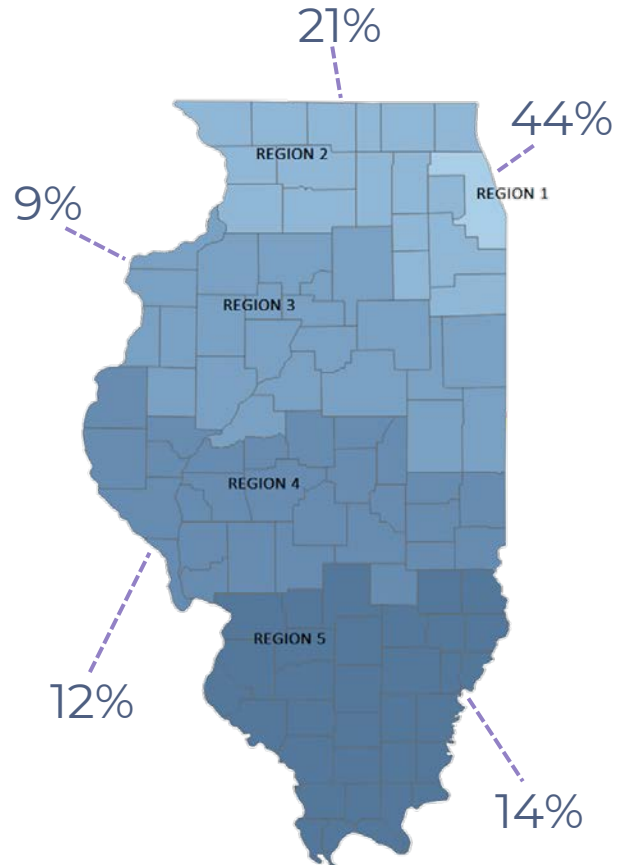
