When the hospital became part of OSF HealthCare in February 2018, The Sisters of the Third Order of St. Francis renamed the hospital to honor the legacy of the founders. Our staff provides state-of-the-art therapeutic, diagnostic, medical, surgical and support services. OSF HealthCare is a Catholic, 17-hospital health system serving Illinois and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, driven by our Mission to serve with the greatest care and love.

OSF Heart of Mary has been recognized for its treatment of heart failure, stroke and total knee and hip replacement, in addition to being the area’s only hospital-based inpatient Adult Behavioral Health unit. We continue to transform with the changing health care landscape to better serve our patients.
