Test Name:

Abdominal Vessels Ultrasound (aorta, mesenteric, portal, renal duplex or TIPS)

Welcome to the OSF Saint Anthony Medical Center Ultrasound Department.

You have been scheduled to have an **abdominal ultrasound** of specific vessels in your belly.

This information will help you understand the test that has been scheduled. Thank you for trusting OSF for your medical imaging needs.

When to come:

Please arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time to check in.

Preparation:

If you are an adult, do not eat, drink, and smoke after midnight prior to the exam. You may take medications with 2-3 sips of water.

If the patient is an infant to 2 years old, hold the last feeding prior to the exam.

If the patient is 2 to 12 years old, nothing to eat or drink 6 hours prior to exam.

Family:

Family or friends may be asked to stay in the waiting area during the test.

Test Instructions:

A registered sonographer will be performing the test. The test will take about 45 minutes. The sonographer will apply a warm gel on your belly, then use a small camera which allows different organs to be seen and pictures are taken. The sonographer may need to review the pictures with a radiologist (a doctor specializing in medical imaging) and/ or vascular surgeon who may request more pictures.

Test Results:

Your test will be read by a radiologist or a vascular surgeon and a report is sent to your ordering doctor. You can make plans with your ordering doctor to receive your test results.
