#### ADVISEMENT / REGISTRATION

#### **Academic Advisement**

- All BSN students MUST meet with an initial J1 Academic Advisor. It is the student's
  responsibility to attend a group advising session. If unable to attend one of the
  group advising sessions, the student must contact Admissions to make other
  arrangements.
- Incoming J1 students will register by selecting a course bundle versus individual
  courses and sections. This will greatly reduce scheduling conflicts for students.
  Course bundles (see Course Bundle Chart) have been created and contain all the
  necessary J1 courses and lab sections to enable a student to be enrolled full time.
  Students will select 3 bundle options. The college will attempt to accommodate the
  students preferences.
- Check prerequisites in the College Catalog on the College website (www.sfmccon.edu). Prerequisites must be met and final transcripts submitted before classes begin.
- The College reserves the right to limit enrollment in sections and to cancel a section for which there are insufficient registrations. The size of a clinical group is determined by limitations set by the clinical agency. The College reserves the right to change or adjust course and clinical or lab schedules of students, as needed.

#### **Full Time Students**

Full-time students will be enrolled into one of the predefined full-time course bundles (A1, A2, A3, A4, B1, B2, B3 or B4). Each full-time course bundle contains a total of 17 credit hours and includes all the J1 course lecture, lab and clinical requirements.

#### **Part Time Students**

Students interested in enrolling part-time should speak to their initial J1 Academic Advisor about part-time options. Part-time options will be discussed at the group advisement sessions.

#### Student Accounts

- Student Account payment is **due December 13**<sup>th</sup> **for the Spring 2026 semester**. Please contact Student Accounts at (309) 655-2344 to make payment arrangements. A monthly late charge of \$25 will be applied to any unpaid balance.
- Students enrolled in 6 credit hours or more may be eligible for federal student loans or other financial assistance. The FAFSA must be filed, and the financial aid process completed, which may take several weeks. For more information, please contact the Student Finance Office at (309) 624-9932.
- OSF Mission Partners utilizing Guild Education benefits for the first time must complete the Guild application at osf.guildeducation.com.

#### **Textbook Information**

- The College of Nursing has no bookstore. Textbooks can be purchased online from various retailers. If you have questions, please call the College Library at 309-655-2180
- The textbook list will be available on the College's website on the library page in October. "Institutional" in the price column means the book is included in your tuition and fees statement and does not need to be purchased.

#### **Minimum Computer Requirements**

- You will receive directions to your personal email address on how to activate your school (.edu) email and login information. Activation must happen within 30 days of receipt of the email. If not activated within the first 30 days, the account becomes deactivated. You will miss important notifications.
- Your login must be used to access the learning management system (Canvas) and the lockdown browser (Respondus) used for exams as well as other College resources.
- You may use the College's computer labs, but you are also required to have your own personal computer. The minimum computer requirements can be found on the College website.
