A. UPDATES FROM IDPH

1. HPP GRANTS

- a. The budget period one will be ending soon. The hospitals will no longer receive individual grants. The grant dollars will go to the RHCC to be used towards the coalition. There will be two grants one will be in the amount of \$250, 000 to function as a RHCC and the second grant is for the Healthcare coalition in the amount of 445,547.
- b. There will need to be a plan developed for the grant money. Troy handed out the grant deliverable document and discussed it with the group. He has 30 days to submit the budget.
- c. There were some suggestions on what to use the funds on, hosting a table top drill, regional exercises, decon trainings, ordering PAPR hoods and filters. Troy also suggested the COOP assessment being one of the exercises. There does need to be a justification on how it would benefit the region. Your ideas are needed.
