OSF HealthCare Sacred Heart Medical Center is a 174-bed comprehensive health care facility serving Vermilion County. It was established in 1882 in a 14-room former hotel by the Franciscan Sisters of the Sacred Heart. When the hospital became part of OSF HealthCare in February 2018, The Sisters of the Third Order of St. Francis renamed it OSF HealthCare Sacred Heart Medical Center to honor the legacy of the original founding Sisters of St. Elizabeth Hospital. Our staff provides state-of-the-art therapeutic, diagnostic, medical, surgical and support services to our patients and their families. OSF HealthCare is a Catholic, 17-hospital health system serving Illinois and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, driven by our Mission to serve with the greatest care and love.
