## About Us

OSF HealthCare Sacred Heart Medical Center is a 174-bed comprehensive health care facility serving Vermilion County. It was established in 1882 in a 14-room former hotel by the Franciscan Sisters of the Sacred Heart. It became part of OSF HealthCare in February 2018. The Sisters of the Third Order of St. Francis renamed it to honor the legacy of the founding Sisters of the original St. Elizabeth Hospital. Our staff provides state-of-the-art therapeutic, diagnostic, medical, surgical and support services to our patients and their families. OSF HealthCare is a Catholic health system with 18 inpatient facilities serving Illinois and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, driven by our Mission to serve with the greatest care and love.

OSF Sacred Heart has a dual campus in Urbana, which is a comprehensive behavioral health facility with 40 dedicated beds for adult behavioral health care and 25 medical surgical beds.
