## About Us

OSF HealthCare Divine Mercy Continuing Care Hospital in Peoria, Illinois, became fully owned and operated by OSF in October 2023 after being under dual-ownership for several years. The 47-bed hospital has a staff that provides compassionate care for patients who need extra support as they transition from one care setting to the next.

The hospital offers all private rooms and is conveniently located off Interstate-74 in Peoria, surrounded by several churches and community centers close to the riverfront.

Our 18 long-term post-acute care beds offer the same intensive care provided in a traditional hospital intensive care unit, but for an extended recovery period. Our 29-bed acute rehabilitation unit is for people who have experienced the effects of an acute injury, impairment or illness.

In both our rehabilitation and long-term acute care settings, we partner with the patient's physician and offer 24-hour clinical care seven days a week.

## Transforming Care

OSF Divine Mercy employs a staff of highly experienced and exceptionally trained Mission Partners. These compassionate caregivers may be found throughout OSF Divine Mercy in clinical and non-clinical roles, performing a variety of services. In addition to providing direct patient care, we coordinate patient care with other disciplines, including nutrition, pharmacy, social and insurance services.
