OSF HealthCare Saint Elizabeth Medical Center is a 97-bed acute care facility, fully accredited by The Joint Commission. With roots in the community dating back to 1895, OSF Saint Elizabeth joined the OSF HealthCare Ministry in 2012. The medical center serves patients throughout Ottawa, Streator and beyond, and through OSF Medical Group clinics in Marseilles, Ottawa and Streator. In April 2024, a second OSF Saint Elizabeth campus began operations in Peru, Illinois, with the opening of an emergency department. Additional inpatient services will be added in the future.

OSF Saint Elizbeth was named a 2023 Human Experience (HX) Guardian of Excellence Award® winner by Press Ganey, the global leader in health care experience solutions and services.
