OSF Saint Francis has grown into the fifth-largest medical center in Illinois, with nearly 6,000 employees and 640+ patient beds. A major teaching affiliate of the University of Illinois College of Medicine Peoria, OSF Saint Francis is the area’s only Level I Trauma Center and tertiary care medical center. We are also home to OSF HealthCare Children’s Hospital of Illinois, OSF HealthCare Cancer Institute and the OSF HealthCare Illinois Neurological Institute. OSF Saint Francis employs a staff of highly experienced and exceptionally trained Mission Partners. These compassionate caregivers may be found throughout OSF Saint Francis in clinical and non-clinical roles, performing a variety of services. In addition to providing direct patient care, we coordinate patient care with other disciplines, including nutrition, pharmacy, social and insurance services, along with senior and weight management services.

This interdisciplinary team meets daily at the bedside with the patient and family to discuss the patient’s goals for discharge, education and equipment needed and patient responsibilities upon discharge.

Community initiatives:

- Faith Community Nursing: Partners with clergy and other health care organizations to advocate for the health and well-being of individuals.
- School Nursing: Provides nursing services to partnering schools and Bradley University.
- OSF Care-a-Van: Travels to where people work, pray and play to connect patients to care.
- Gardens of Hope: Two locations where people gather to build friendships, beautify their neighborhood and promote good nutrition through education and by growing healthy food.
- Children’s Advocacy: Checked 274 car seats and distributed 326 low-cost car seats in the hospital and through vouchers with community partners.
- OSF Strive-Trauma Recovery Center: Provides psychotherapy, case management, referrals to victim services and assertive outreach. Served 904 clients in FY25.
