Founded in 1880 by The Sisters of the Third Order of St. Francis, OSF St. Joseph was the second hospital in the OSF Ministry. OSF St. Joseph is designated a Magnet hospital for nursing excellence. With its strong connection to OSF HealthCare Children’s Hospital of Illinois, OSF St. Joseph offers maternal-fetal medicine, 24/7 neonatology and local access to several pediatric specialties. OSF St. Joseph is a Baby-Friendly Hospital.

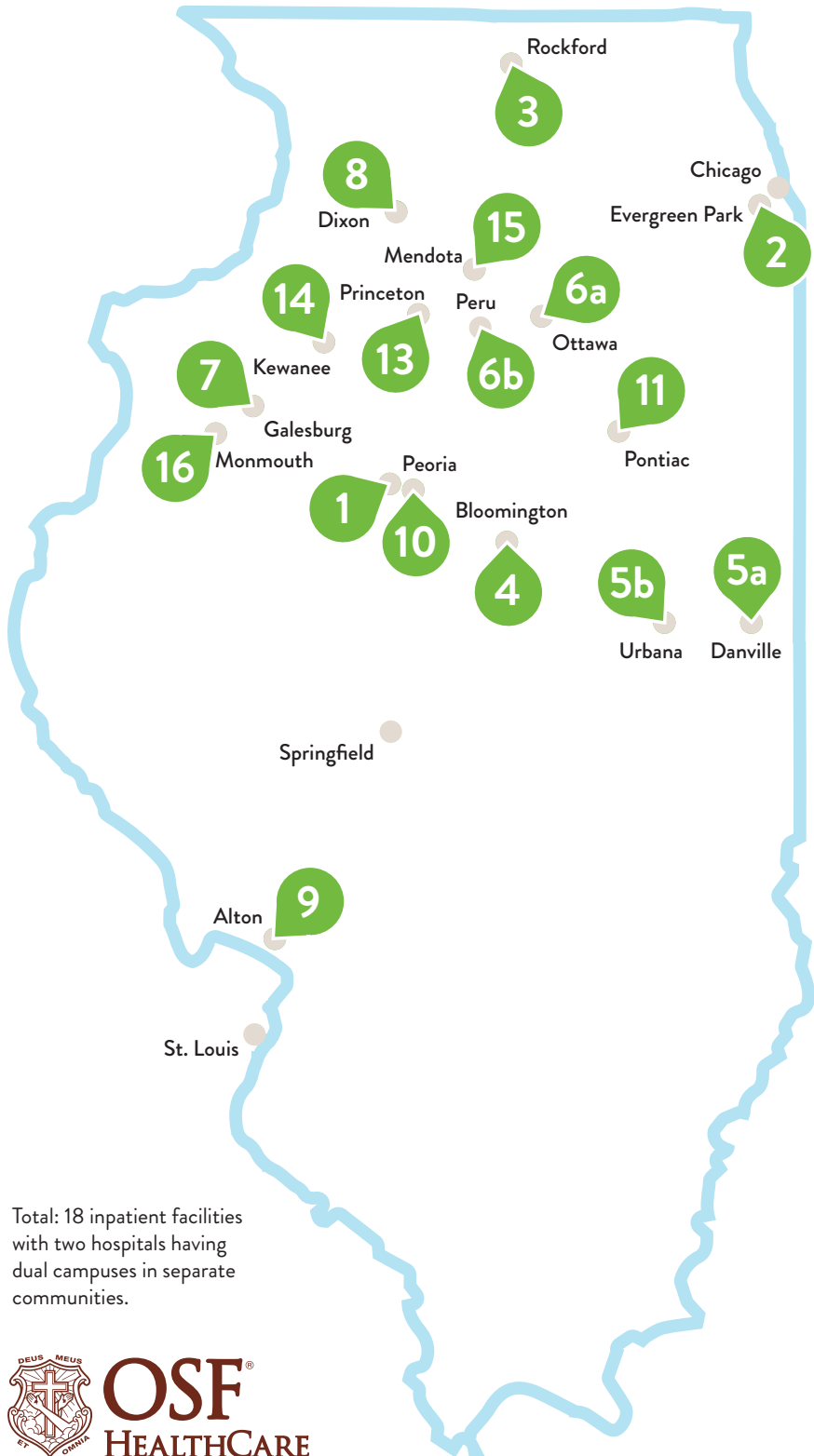
