ADVISEMENT / REGISTRATION

Academic Advisement

- Advisement for Spring 2026 ends October 3rd.
- All currently enrolled RN to BSN students MUST meet individually with his/her Academic Advisor. It is the student's responsibility to make an appointment to see the advisor.
- Review your current Plan of Study with your Academic Advisor.
- When meeting with the Academic Advisor is completed, the Academic Advisor will email course selection to the Registrar if plan of study changes are necessary. Before leaving the meeting make sure this has been done by your advisor.

Registration

- The college will register each student for the Spring semester according to their plan of study between October 6-10. After October 10th, you may check your SONIS account for your Spring schedule.
- Students will not be registered for courses if they have delinquent financial obligations to the College or to financial aid programs.
- The College reserves the right to limit enrollment in sections and to cancel a section for which there are insufficient registrations. The size of a clinical group is determined by limitations set by the clinical agency. The College reserves the right to change or adjust course and clinical or lab schedules of students, as needed.

Student Account

- Student Account payment is due December 12th. Please contact Student Accounts at 309-655-2344 to make payment arrangements. A monthly late charge of \$25 will be applied to any unpaid balance.
- Students enrolled in 6 credit hours or more may be eligible for federal student loans or other financial assistance. The FAFSA must be filed, and the financial aid process complete which may take several weeks. For more information, please contact the Student Finance Office at 309-624-9932.
