  - 4. The Quad Cities will be hosting a CMS, 17 healthcare provider exercise on October 23, 2019. There will be a siren notice getting sent out because they are exercising that as part of the program. They did a tabletop but now they are going to do a full scale exercise on a measles outbreak within their facility. There are three different 2 hour shifts you can sign up for if you are interested.
  - 5. ISU will be hosting a disaster exercise on tornados hitting sometime in April. They are currently in the planning stages right now. This will be held at the ISU grade school and they are in need of some volunteers for this event. This event will be an all pediatric surge.
  - 6. Bureau and Putnam will be hosting a 2 day foodborne illness, exercise. This event will include a mixture of different type of providers.
