About Us

OSF HealthCare Saint Anthony Medical Center in Rockford is a 241-bed tertiary care facility, Level I Trauma Center and regional referral center serving a 10-county area. The hospital is known for being the first and longest-certified comprehensive stroke center, and is the only certified burn center in north central Illinois. It is the first medical center in the Rockford region to perform transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) surgery and Watchman implants for heart patients.

It's home to OSF HealthCare Cardiovascular Institute, OSF Medical Group - Primary Care, OSF HealthCare Illinois Neurological Institute, OSF Medical Group - Surgery and the only cancer center in Rockford to be triple-accredited in oncology practice: overall cancer care, medical oncology and radiation oncology.

In its 2024-25 Best Hospitals rankings, U.S. News & World Report named OSF HealthCare Saint Anthony Medical Center as high performing in three adult procedures/conditions: knee replacement, stroke care and pacemaker implementation. OSF Saint Anthony is a five-time Magnet Designated hospital, the first and longest in Rockford.
